


## CMS' STRUCTURE





### EDITING TOOLS – DEPENDENCY MANAGER

- Every page and file in the CMS gets a unique ID number
  - "Dependency Tag"
- When making links, the CMS uses the ID number, not a URL
- Links to files get automatically updated when they move or are renamed
- Broken links will only come from deleted files



#### Assets



- Provide a single source of content for use on multiple pages
- When you want to <u>reuse content</u> and <u>structure/styling</u>
- Not customizable on page
- Pages update automatically
- Five types:
  - Web Content
  - Plain Text
  - Source Code
  - Image Gallery
  - Forms

#### **Snippets**



- Insert predefined content into a page while editing and are often used for pieces of content with specific formatting
- When you want to <u>reuse structure/styling</u>, but keep <u>content</u> <u>unique</u>
- Customizable on page
- Changes to one page won't affect other pages
- Makes it easier to edit complex blocks of content in WYSIWYG

#### **Components**



- Gather information and adds it into complex design elements
- When you want to reuse <u>structure/styling</u>, but keep <u>content</u> <u>unique</u>
- Uses form fields to prompt for content
- Customize content on each page
- Changes to the Component's base code WILL be reflected across all pages with the Component
